

Natural Coral Rock and Sand




A Living Landscape

Look closer and they're anything but ordinary. Once alive, breathing and growing, these coral skeletons have found a new purpose: housing millions of micro-organisms. In a way, they're still alive, reef keeping hobbyists call them "live rock" because they are teeming with life. Essentially, these porous rocks act as a biological filter, allowing de-nitrifying bacteria to live, breed, and convert noxious waste into a benign form of nutrients which shrimp can later eat.



Aragonite Sand

The ideal substrate for marine life. Maintains proper pH and encourages beneficial bacteria.





Coral Rubble

Porous rock from coral skeletons and calcareous algae. Cured for optimal ecology.







Large Coral

Available by request. Large, mostly intact pieces, great for center displays and showcases.

Shrimp Questions

Do I have to clean or feed?

You do not have to feed or clean. Over time algae may build up on the inside of the glass, but cleaning is not necessary. A supply of algae is the food source for the shrimp and is not harmful in small quantities.

How long will they survive?

Shrimp in AquaCoves can survive a few years (3+) if kept in the proper environment (stable temperatures with indirect light). Larger units can last longer (10+ years) through successive generations. Ultimately we cannot know how long a shrimp will live, so of course these are estimates and not guaranteed.

What happens if a shrimp dies?

If you notice a pale, gray skeleton at the bottom, this is actually the molted exoskeleton of a living shrimp and a sign that the shrimp is healthy! Otherwise, if the body is pale red, or fuzzy, it may have died. It's normal for shrimp to die over time, but their death won't cause harm to other shrimp.
